In the same manner, at present, there is tension between India and Pakistan because of negative thinking. The screams of their voices struck the ears of Dr. Back and made him determined to do some help to these unfortunate patients. He began to look after more and more patients per day ignoring his own sufferings. This service gave him immense self-confidence, satisfaction, and joy and he devoted himself fully to the service of these wounded patients and rescued them from the mouth of death and destruction. In due course, the light of courage and confidence went on increasing. Within a period of three, his sincere and hard labor improved his health and he felt himself stronger and stronger. His deep and firm faithful reduced his own ailments from within himself and the man who was to have lived only for six months achieved victory over his death, based on the strength of his hard work and positive thinking. His wholehearted application and devotion to duties gave life to hundreds of his patients and taught them the art of fighting against difficulties in life. This unprecedented magic filled his book spirit and made him take steps for the well-being of mankind so that the future generation may take lessons from his positive thinking. This enabled him to discover remedies to fight against the difficulties he faced. Dr. Back did achieve victory over death. With the help of positive thinking, self-confidence, and confidence in spirit, one can fight against any number of the biggest and the most painful difficulties and sufferings. In search of such remedies, he lost himself and indulged himself to a search of such remedies he lost himself and indulged himself to search flowers and leaves to prepare remedies from them. Based on these constructive thoughts. Dr. Back invented nearly 36 remedies from flowers and leaves of shrubs and trees till 1930 A.D. With these remedies, man can calm his mind, become peaceful, and be able to reduce the incidence of pains and tension. These remedies

lead to self-awakening of spiritual force from within, with the help of which, one gets the spirit of fighting against any disease of the body and mind. Thus Dr. Back restored confidence in man's spirit with the help of natural remedies he invented and taught the art of living to thousands of patients. The same man, who was destined to die in despair and disappointment in 1916 A.D., achieved victory over death invented remedies for human welfare and lived till 1936 A.D. If man wins over defeat and keeps away from disappointments and begins to lead his life on the strength of his spirit, he is sure to win success. Just as truth prevails, however much it is suppressed, in the face of hard work and sincere application, all obstacles will distance themselves away and all directions of success will reveal themselves to him.

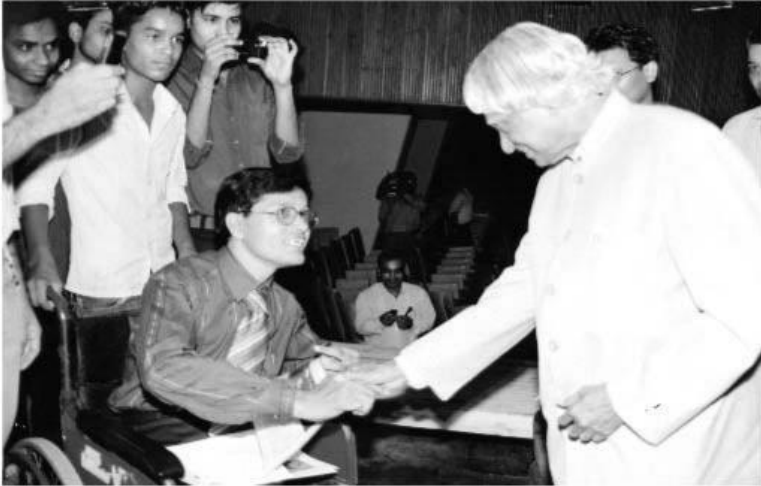

I want to introduce myself to you. Ever since I was 12 years old, I am living the life of a handicapped person. Before that, I used to play, jumping, hopping and skipping, just like any other children of my age. Suddenly, because of an event in my life, I became a victim of an accident and have been living a life of a handicapped person. On the advice of doctors, I had to stop going to school. In a few years, since then, my mental state also began to sag and conditions of my body also began to deteriorate.

In view of this, I became helpless for a long time. Even friends and children could not help me participate with them in their games. Secluded, I began to think within myself that I should go forward and beyond, beyond all my friends and achieve some tangible, some unique success and serve my country. Being unable to get good medical care, I got along with the help of hopeful attitude till 1996. In that year my bones were damaged and I became helpless. Because of broken bones, I have been spending my life in a wheelchair, since then, to date. I am compelled to take recourse of somebody's assistance. But the strength of my spirit made me forget my shortcomings and helplessness and goaded me strongly to move ahead and achieve something, for the well-being of the whole country. From then on, I loaded on my shoulders, the burden of world peace and moved ahead spreading and instilling peace and moved ahead spreading and instilling peace in the minds of millions of people around me and make them do all possible programs in search of peace. I have achieved success.

Even though it is full of challenges and it involves diverse functions, my mind has established a rock of faith and determination in me. I will continue to hold the torch of worldwide peace and I will not stop till I achieve success on the strength and footsteps of positive thinking. This is the firm objective of my spirited life. My efforts will continue to advocate stopping the production of lethal weapons and to stop wars forever from the face of our earth. Lo! When can I witness a situation when our planet earth gets rid of treachery on its soil when all the mankind on earth will be able to lead a life of peace and freedom? Efforts towards this indeed are the truth and this, indeed, is life. True success is certain to the sincere endeavor. Various experiences of my life in this field will unfold themselves in what follows. You can witness various peace attempts in the picture below.

Confined to the four walls of my home, main activities like spreading the message of peace through the medium of poems and radiate enlightenment of positive thinking, through new year greetings and a strong will to achieve something tangible, have been the beacon light of all my endeavors. Because people who are handicapped are viewed, with pity, as helpless beggars and alms-mongers, - even if they come forward to achieve something in life, they are reminded of all their shortcomings, stopping them from moving forward. I was also a victim of such a legacy because I had already started spreading peace messages through thousands of letters to every nook and corner of the world, purely at my own cost. I got an encouraging and positive response through letters from many countries appreciating of my attempts to spread peace. Even now such letters continue to pour in. At last, an organization by name “World Wide Peace Organization” was established under whose canopy, various peace-related activities and programs have continued to take shape with full speed. Because of financial constraints, I had to take loans from banks and spend them towards spreading world peace, in search of a bright future. But my physical and financial conditions deteriorated further. As I could not repay the loans in time, notices from banks and courts continued to



threaten me; but due to my firm resolve based on the strong foundation of the path of peace, I got alone despite all these difficulties, without being baffled and without becoming panicky and nervous because, we have come across many a great person in history who faced similar poverty and fought with them and hoisted the flags of victory based on self-confidence and self-motivation.

Our lives are like those of a sculpture who, with his beautiful artistic creativity, carves out an idol using his implements. In the same manner, we are the architects of our life. In Ambassa we were living in rented house and nearby we had a rainwater well. It was hardly 40 feet deep all-around people used to take water from this well for necessary livelihood. Around the well, I use to play with other children and one morning I was playing with the rope which was tied with empty water iron bucket and pulling outside after dropping into the dry deep well. All of sudden I fell into the dry well and within a movement after two rounds in the year I forcibly stand on two cross wooden which was placed into the depth of the dry well. I was too much frightened with this incident. I cried with loud voice mother mother mother and after listening my cry voice within minutes, my mother came, along with another lady, and with the help of a bucket tied to a rope, rescued me. This was my first simple victory over death. Thank God, nothing happened to me from this incident except some scratch on my waist. At last, I had to go to Delhi in 1971 A.D. with all our family members as my father was transferred from Tripura to Delhi on Government duty. Again, in April 1974 A.D., I fell down from my cot in my house and got a small injury on my knees above my leg, initially. I became septic and then onwards, I had to lead a life of helplessness and vain. A barrage of helplessness began to crowd my spirit. Amidst all my helplessness, one day, I happened to witness a film – Anand – in which Rajesh Khanna, my beloved and revered film star, held the leading role. I had the opportunity of seeing the same movie a number of times, again and again. In that film, Rajesh Khanna held the role of a cancer patient, who, according to this family doctor, had only six more months of life on earth. The hero was also well aware of the shadow of death hanging over his head to devour him in a few months time. The hero wanted to lead this fight against

death, all in smiles and happiness, spreading joy to everybody around him. He betook a very lofty ideal for the rest of his life and lived his life in Evergreen splendor and accepted his certain destiny, spreading joy among all the circles of his relatives and friends. Contemplating on this role in his life against imminent death, a stream of questions arose in my sad and dejected life. In my heart of heart, I decided to uphold and live a life of positive

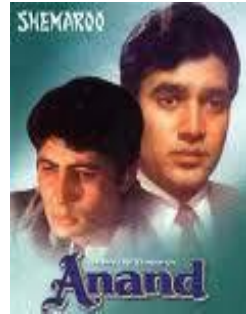

thinking for the rest of my life and resolved that, if possible, I will dedicate my life to social welfare. From then onwards, I started nourishing and music poems of hope and courage in my thoughts. This was my first poem.

My father was also running an organization called “An Academy of Brothers and Sisters of India”, with an avowed objective of fastening the strength of Hindu-Muslim unity and solidarity in the country. But I found that society did not approve and befriend my father’s ideals. Society rejected him. History claims that daring social reformers who devoted to their goal, had had to face and tread through a path of fire of ordeal whether they be, Mahatma Gandhi, Mother Teresa, Martin Luther or anyone else, whom we respect now. But in their times, they were the victims of mockery and jeer, victims of pain and torture, but they did not bow before them. Their spirit from within lent strong support and they became successful. Even now, I remember that moment when, during a seminar on peace, held at Rajghat in New Delhi, the invited guest speaker spoke on Mike, introducing me to the audience, that Mr. Sager, despite his ailments and constraints of the body, has been treading on path of world peace which is full of fire – such a burning fire that will engulf everybody turning everything into ashes, including him.

I am ready to face such a fire and get scorched, if it needs my sacrifice and serves a just cause and noble purpose and I am confident that victory will be on my side, and that too, in my own lifetime. World honors and salutes this very fire that keeps burning

from strength to strength amidst the whirlwinds of all oppositions. So, without minding petty troubles on the way, and shunning all attempts of mock and jeer, we should go ahead in the direction of upholding of our cherished goal with hope and courage. Victory garlands you and you will succeed. Just like a little lamp dispenses darkness, however deep, the light of your heart and spirit, will be able to dispel all the impending troubles, however hard they be. This very torch will enlighten the waves of strength in everybody as well as the waves of world peace.

I handed over to them some papers and stickers on world peace, going through which, they were astonished. I told them that life is the name of such incidents. This is an event, which I will remember forever.

But I am confident on my success, on my goal, on my self-confidence and this is the very medicine of my life and elixir of my soul, which fills my heart with joy and happiness. The girl, who was turned away by society, went on passing all her examinations one after another. Finally, she secured the degree of Master of Arts (M.A.) in English language. She awakened the society through her example, that physical handicap is no more a limit or burden to anybody, who has the will power and self-confidence to go ahead and succeed. ## Hail World Peace!

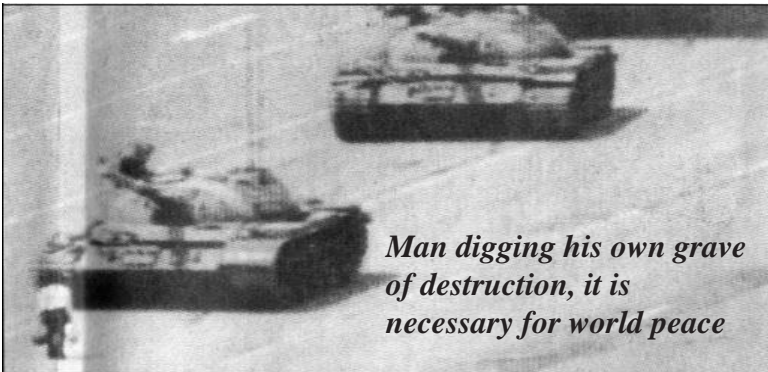

Where did those anti-Hindi shouts and slogans disappear? abandon the earth because of droughts? In the absence of water, land shows man to survive despite being parched. On the same land grow grasses, shrubs

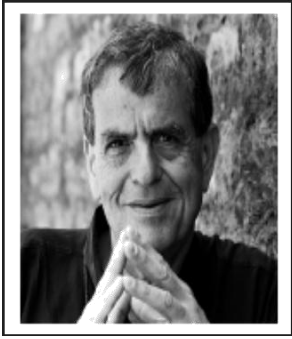
